YOUR SAFETY IS OUR CONCERN - COVID-19

As Captain of Robbie Bobby I wanted to provide you with an update on the measures that we are taking to ensure your health, wellbeing and safety whilst you are on board Robbie Bobby. We have all faced an unprecedented situation as a result of Covid-19. A yacht is a far safer place to be than probably any hotel as we can control our environment, we control what and who comes on board. We can take you to beaches and coves where few people, if any, ever visit. The crew on-board Robbie Bobby have been quarantined on the yacht since mid-February 2020 to reduce the risk of being infected by the COVID 19 virus. While you are on board the crew will be checked daily with temperature controls. I have taken my crew through extensive training about the virus and how to ensure that you are kept safe while on board. We are now all ready and we look forward to welcoming you and your family.

Before you arrive

We understand there is uncertainty at this time, therefore we want to reassure you about what we are doing to keep our yacht clean to the highest standards. We are, as a base standard, following the guidance from health authorities and the yachting industry, however we are actually doing much more to keep you safe. Before and after every departure the yacht goes through a deep clean. This means that all the cabins, toilets, bathrooms, lounge seats, sky lounge, main salon, hallways and all public areas are thoroughly cleaned by our stewardess team with disinfectants that are proven to kill bacteria. Additionally, we have purchased two Hextio machines (www.radic8.com) which are the world's highest certified air cleaners that destroy all air pollutants including viruses, bacteria and traffic pollution. We use this in each room on a daily basis to ensure the elimination of all bacteria. From the moment you step on board Robbie Bobby you will be offered hand sanitizer and this is always available around the yacht for both guests and crew to use.

Upon arrival

Upon arrival at the quay side you will be asked to sanitize your hands and remove your shoes (which we will sanitize for you) before stepping on board this beautiful yacht for a holiday of a lifetime. My crew will use sterilized wipes to give your luggage a clean before carrying them to your cabin. Your welcome on board will include a refreshing drink and cooled hand towels to wipe away the stress of travelling.



Visiting ports whilst on your charter

I will discuss your preferred itinerary with you before we depart. Should you wish to visit any ports or towns then we will happily do so for you. We will advise you about your safety and suggest what measures you and your family should take in that particular location. Upon re-boarding Robbie Bobby, we will follow the same routine as set out above, when you first boarded.

Goods brought on to Robbie Bobby

We currently disinfect all items on the quay side prior to bringing anything on board. Should you make purchases from outside that you wish to bring on board then we will happily de-sanitize these for you.

The Crew

The crew will be tested for COVID-19 prior to any guest arrivals. The vessel will also be professionally cleaned with a certified sterilization company prior to any charters. Above all else we would like to reassure you that the safety, health and well-being of our guests and crew is, and always will be, our number one priority.

External contractors

Although highly unlikely during your charter, we occasionally need to use an external contractor. Should we do so, they have to go through a screening process prior to boarding and it is compulsory for them to wear gloves and a face mask while onboard. Social distancing is enforced and contact with crew is kept to an absolute minimum. The temperature of any contractor is taken before they board, and a check list waiver is signed.
